

Terra Vita Hub - Executive Brief for Committees

Institutional Governance & Assurance Infrastructure

Purpose

Terra Vita Hub provides institutional-grade governance and assurance infrastructure for programmes operating across agriculture, climate, and sovereign decision environments. It separates narrative from reliance-grade evidence, defines a governed evidence spine, and enables auditable, attribution-based decision reconstruction.

Core Institutional Posture

Governance infrastructure, not a product.	Terra Vita Hub functions as a structural layer for evidence, verification, and risk architecture.
Non-substitution stance.	No automated signal can create or alter a binding approval, disbursement, or policy decision.
Reliance boundary defined.	Public narrative is informational; formal reliance requires protected diligence artefacts.

Governance Spine Overview

Governed Evidence Intake	Attribution, timestamps, integrity controls, permissions.
IAL - Interpretation & Calibration	Transparent logic, safeguards, and conditions.
IRI - Reviewer Governance & Reliability	Reviewer routing, calibration, divergence detection.
Decision & Authorization	Human approvals, committee routing, decision snapshots.
MRV Integration	Verification data attached without overwriting history.
Export & Audit Trail	Reproducible committee packs, attribution logs, audit reconstruction.
Eligibility Output	Funding readiness and reliance conditions.

Institutional Journey

Step 1	Read the Executive 4-Page Brief	Primary committee artefact.
Step 2	Use the Institutional Review Index	Route reviewers and access governance materials.
Step 3	Issue the Minimum Evidence Request	Route procurement, IT/security and vendor-risk teams before formal approval.
Step 4	Access Protected Diligence Materials	Control Evidence Boundary, Operational Assurance and protected walkthrough materials form the reliance basis.

Assurance Posture

Certifications: SOC 2 / ISO 27001 roadmap in progress. External pen tests: independent testing posture and summaries are available under protected diligence where applicable. SLAs and DR testing: maintained and verifiable through deployment-specific artefacts.

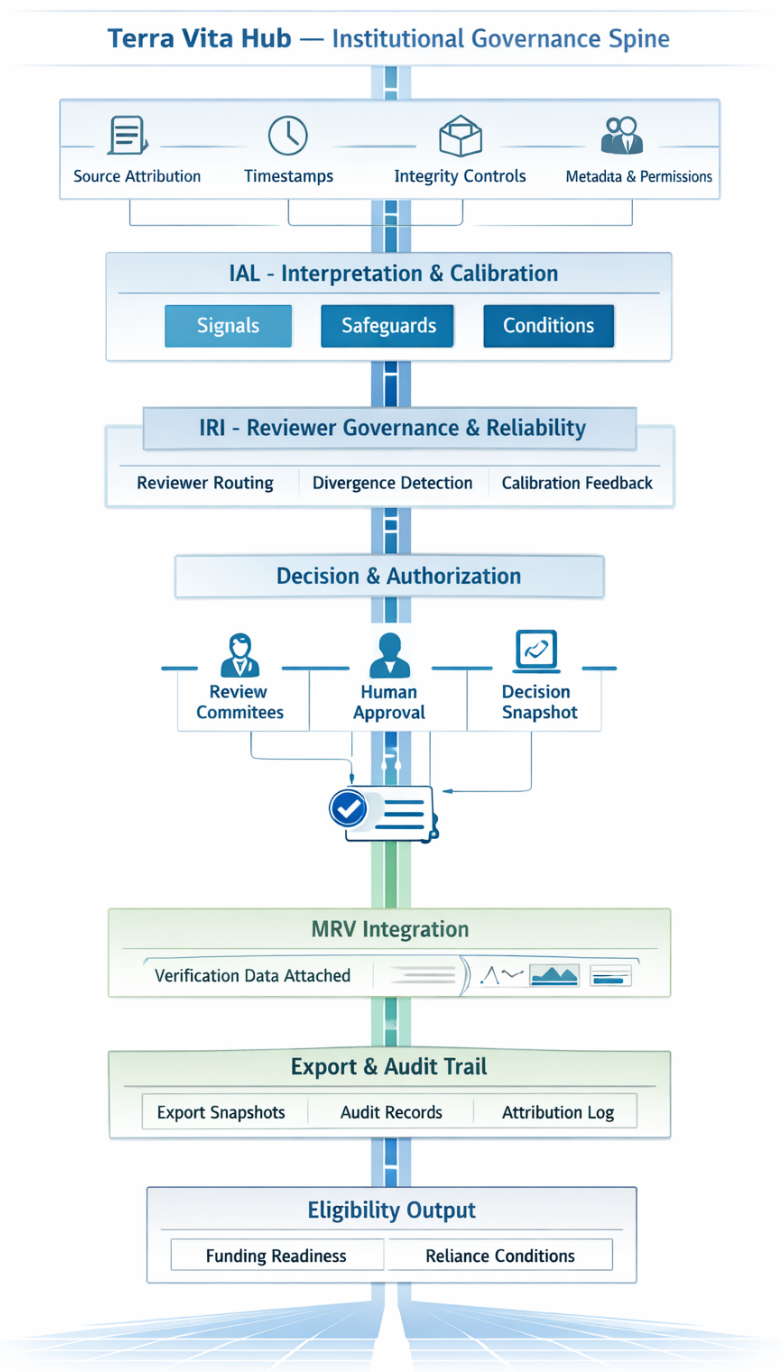
Institutional Verdict

Terra Vita Hub is positioned for Tier-1 institutional review. Its institutional posture is designed to meet the governance, assurance, and procurement expectations of ministries, MDBs/DFIs, sovereign programmes, and auditors when the public narrative is validated against protected, deployment-specific proof.
