Executive Four-Page Institutional Brief

1. What Terra Vita Hub Is

Reliance boundary: Terra Vita Hub structures evidence, routing, assurance and export posture. It does not approve, finance, regulate, rate, certify or replace authorised institutional judgement.

Terra Vita Hub is governance and MRV infrastructure for institutional review. It provides a controlled decision environment where evidence, reviewer routing, assurance conditions and export readiness are structured before institutional reliance.

COMMITTEE BRIEF

2. Authority Boundary

Institutions retain binding authority.

- Institutions retain statutory and fiduciary authority.
- MRV methodologies remain under competent national or programme authority.
- No AI signal, score, dashboard value or automated output can approve, reject, regulate or disburse.
- Protected evidence is purpose-bound and reviewer-attributed.

3. Governance Spine

The control architecture behind institutional review.

The spine consists of seven control layers: identity, evidence, routing, assurance, MRV attachment, export and audit reconstruction. These layers make review behaviour predictable and replayable without replacing the institution.

4. Reviewer Route

From public orientation to protected diligence and committee export.

The recommended route is: public orientation, institutional review index, minimum evidence request, protected diligence, committee export. This creates a single path from public trust-building to protected reliance-grade review.
